Vineyard: The grapes were harvested from the Covarrubias block.

Fermentation: The grapes were partially fermented in stainless steel tanks then fortified with oak-aged brandy before being placed in barrel.

Aging: The wine was aged for 11 months in 60% neutral and 40% new American oak barrels.

Description: Our 2007 vintage has flavors of blackberry pie, ripe black cherries and dark chocolate complemented by nuances of coffee bean, spice and a fruit forward mid palate.

History: Founded 125 years ago, Wente Vineyards is the country's oldest continuously operated family-owned winery. Owned and managed today by the fourth and fifth generations of the Wente family, the winery draws from nearly 3,000 acres of estate vineyards in the Livermore Valley, San Francisco Bay, and Arroyo Seco, Monterey winegrowing regions to make an outstanding portfolio of wines.
